**Subject: Additional products included in Daniele International Italian Sausage Recall Due to Possible *Salmonella* Contamination**

Daniele International Inc., an establishment with operations in Pascoag and Mapleville, R.I., today again expanded its current recall of ready-to-eat (RTE) varieties of Italian sausage products to include approximately 23,754 additional pounds of product because they may be contaminated with *Salmonella*.

Local health departments are also encouraged to periodically check the updated recall website [http://www.fsis.usda.gov/News & Events/Recall\\_006\\_2010\\_Release/index.asp](http://www.fsis.usda.gov/News_&_Events/Recall_006_2010_Release/index.asp) for a current listing of recalled products. As additional products are recalled, they will be included on this website.

Individuals who contact local health departments reporting symptoms and a history of consuming the recalled products should be referred to their Primary Care Physician for evaluation and follow-up. Additionally, the 3-page Foodborne Alert form should be completed and faxed to the Food Protection Program. Laboratory confirmed cases with a history of consuming the recalled product should be interviewed per the Epidemiology Program's protocol using the appropriate form. The FPP is working with the Department of Consumer Protection (DCP), who is aware of the recall, and should be contacted, at (860) 713-6160 for questions related to the products.

The additional products subject to recall include:

- **3-ounce packages of "DANIELE NATURALE SALAME COATED WITH COARSE BLACK PEPPER"**
- **Approximately 6-pound packages of "DANIELE SALAME GRANDE COATED WITH PORK FAT & PEPPER"**

Each package bears a label with establishment number "EST. 54 or 9992" inside the USDA mark of inspection. The establishment is recalling all the products listed above which are currently in commerce. These products were distributed to retail establishments nationwide.
